Much like our Walk to Emmaus 72-hour prayer vigil, we will be calling out to God to touch people's hearts.

Folks may walk and pray, gather at their churches and pray, pray from home, or pray at the local community building where we are gathering to begin the Prayer Walk and then returning for a meal together and reflection.

I share this as a reminder that prayer works. Whether you have experienced the power of prayer yourself, you know others who have had first-hand knowledge of prayer at work. Our group plans to experience a change in our community and a change in our church.
